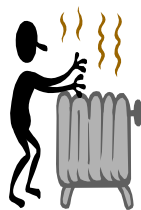

REDETERMINATION OF RENT, DWELLING SIZE AND ELIGIBILITY

Section II, Paragraph 5 (a-2) of your Dwelling Lease states:

Any change of income experienced by Resident or Resident's household should be reported within ten (10) days of its occurrence with proper written verification from income source.

Submit to **your Property Manager** any documentation that supports your change (ie. Termination letters, pay stubs {new/old job}, unemployment letters, Social Security Administration letters, CCR&R forms, child care expenses, etc.).

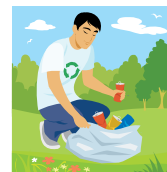

Healthy Tips to Avoid Colds and the Flu:

With the winter months approaching the cold and flu season draws near too. Developing simple healthy habits can help to avoid colds and the flu this season and throughout the year.

- *Colds and the flu are often spread by hand-to-hand contact. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth after touching unclean surfaces*
- *Frequently clean surfaces such as stair rails, telephones, counter tops and door knobs to avoid hand-to-hand spread of viruses.*
- *Cover your nose and mouth when you cough and sneeze, preferably with a facial tissue or your arm, not your hands.*
- *Wash your hands frequently with liquid antibacterial soap instead of bar soap.*
- *Get plenty of restful sleep. Your body recharges itself at night.*
- *Drink water everyday. Staying hydrated is essential to your health.*
- *Stop smoking. Smoking affects your respiratory system and increases your vulnerability to viruses that cause colds and the flu.*
- *Exercise regularly. Thirty minutes of moderate exercise, such as walking, helps your body's ability to fight disease.*
- *Reduce stress and think positively. Being optimistic, happy with life and generally easy going is part of being healthy.*
