Want to Avoid Having to Repay Back Rent?

The best way to avoid having to make a repayment on back rent is to make sure you are reporting all of your income and household changes timely and correctly. Have you recently gotten a new job? Lost a job? Gotten approved for unemployment, SSI, or TANF? If any of those things apply, you must notify us right away! **Failure to do so will result in a repayment agreement and possibly even cause you to lose your voucher due to fraud.** We don't want this and we know you don't either!
